Web Design Training Course, Dublin

Course Overview

This Web Design training course is part-time and runs in the evening over two five week terms. Training is delivered in Ballyfermot, Dublin 10.

The course is aimed at those who are considering a career in Web Page Design. Course content includes:

- HTML 5 and CSS 3
- Dreamweaver and Notepad ++
- Web site planning, design and construction
- W3C and web standards
- Hosting a web site
- Mobile Device web page design introduction
- Blogs and using WordPress themes introduction

The main focus of the course is on web page layout and styling using HTML 5 and CSS 3. Learners create multiple web sites (single and multi-page), both in class and at home, through guided tasks and projects.

The applications used on the course are Dreamweaver, a WYSIWYG application, and Notepad ++, a text editor.

Pre-Requisites

To be able to participate fully in the course learners should have:

- 1. a basic knowledge of HTML and CSS
- 2. good file management skills (ability to create and copy files and folders)
- 3. access to the Dreamweaver application at home
- 4. access to the internet at home

The certification for this course is the QQI <u>5N1910</u> "Web Authoring" certification. The aim of the award is to give the learner the knowledge, skill, and competence to effectively use Hypertext Mark-up Language (HTML 5), Cascading Style Sheets (CSS 3), a <u>WYSIWYG</u> application, and Text Editor in the construction, testing and maintenance of a professional web site.

This is a QQI level 5 single credit award. This module is part of several level 5 Major awards such as eBusiness (5M0828).
